WARMWINTER CLOTHES COLLECTION for Pine Ridge

During October OOW will be collecting <u>warm</u> winter clothes for Native Americans of all ages on the Pine Ridge Indian Reservation in South Dakota. These clothes are desperately needed by people living in a <u>very cold climate</u> in one of the poorest counties in the U.S.

Urgently needed are the following <u>new or gently used</u> items in sizes toddler through adult, with a special need for clothes for elementary school students.

- Good warm, gently used winter coats (no thin coats or jackets)
- Warm hats, gloves, mittens (no thin gloves, mittens or hats)
- Warm socks especially for grade school aged children
 - Snow pants for children and youth
 - Warm sleeping Bags
