



HOMESHARE - An Innovative Housing Solution

Neighbor to Neighbor and the Partnership for Age Friendly Communities in Larimer County are introducing a new and innovative housing program "HomeShare". HomeShare is a housing matching service designed to match homeowners, 55 years and older (home provider) with people looking for an affordable rental (home seeker). Benefits of the program include: safe housing solution for the home provider and home seeker; increased financial capabilities; provide mutual assistance; matching facilitated by Neighbor to Neighbor Housing Counselor; and support provided for a 6 month period after the match. Neighbor to Neighbor will begin to facilitate matches in early 2018. At this time they are building a list of home providers. Brochures are available in the church office on the program. 
