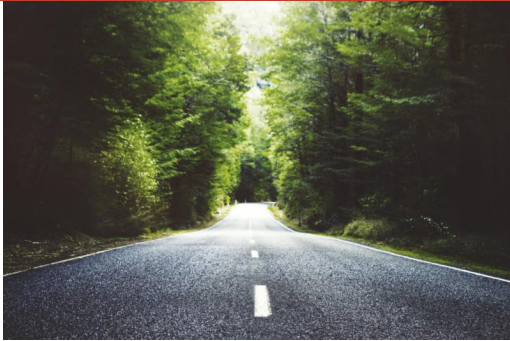

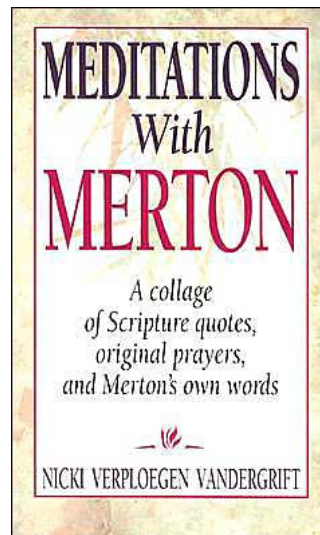


Meditations With Merton

Meditations With Merton is a collage of reflections, with Merton as your guide. Centered on selected passages from Merton's writings, Vandergrift has written 30 brief meditations on themes such as personal integrity, sanctity, identity, integration, God, labor, solidarity and service, words of God, God's will, and love. Related Scripture passages and an original prayer complete each meditation.

Thomas Merton (1915-1968) is arguably the most influential American Catholic author of the twentieth century. His autobiography, *The Seven Storey Mountain*, has sold over one million copies and has been translated into over fifteen languages. He wrote over sixty other books and hundreds of poems and articles on topics ranging from monastic spirituality to civil rights, nonviolence, and the nuclear arms race.

Dear Parents and Guardians of Preschool - 2nd Grade Students:
At OSLC we believe that all are welcome to the table of communion regardless of age. We also believe in upholding our baptismal promise to you, to walk with you in teaching your children about the Christian faith. Therefore, we provide instruction on the sacrament of communion. We want to honor family traditions and we will give communion to anyone at any age, however, we want to do this in conjunction with age appropriate education. This is why you won't hear us say 'first communion' but instead 'communion class' because we do want everyone to participate in the education regardless of whether it's their first communion or whether they have been taking communion for many years.

Second grade has been the traditional year for this to be the Milestone Ministry Class, we are still asking for 2nd graders to come and we are extending the invitation to families with younger children that would like to participate.

We are looking forward to seeing you and your child for this class on Sunday April 14th from 1:00-3:30pm. We will have activities and instruction, prepare the bread for Maundy Thursday worship, practice receiving communion in the sanctuary and to prepare for our leadership roles in worship on Maundy Thursday, April 18th at 7:00pm.
