Collaborative Intern Proposal for OSLC

General Information: Wartburg Seminary has begun a Collaborative Intern program and asked us to consider a specific intern relationship. A collaborative program through this seminary means that the student works half time in a congregation and half time on studies over a four year period. The intern lives in the community where they work and has 'live' (meaning in person) class online. The first 18 months the intern is employed by the church to do the types of ministry most needed in the congregation at that time. The next 18 months the intern has some specific internship learning that needs to occur. The last 12 months is negotiated during the internship as to what will be the best use of time and ministry skills. OSLC will begin with utilizing this person in the area of Youth and Family ministry.

Person: The intern that is being proposed for OSLC is Jon Fry. He is currently working in Campus Ministry in lowa and will begin his theological education this fall. Jon is moving to the front range in June and hopes to have a placement before the fall semester begins. His bio is on the following page

Rationale for Proposal: The council, personnel, and pastors believe that having an intern has great benefits to OSLC and to our contribution to the wider church. We find ourselves in a need for increased ministry staffing that can be flexible and relatable to a number of areas, specifically youth and family ministry, pastoral care, and community connections. OSLC is also a great congregation to learn in and among. We feel it is a healthy place to be a teaching congregation as well as be open to new models of ministry that will we will learn from having a seminary student.

Cost Estimate:

Compensation Package \$2907 per month

Fees per year (not part of the pay package): \$1900
