**Read** Romans 1:17. This was the verse that hit Luther like a lightning bolt that it is through God's grace that we are all saved, not any actions of our own. Read this out loud three times together pausing for 10 seconds between each reading. What do you notice differently each time you read it? Or do you?

What is this "grace" thing anyway?

What does "grace" mean to you?



Luther had a moment of clarity that all people should know this truth and live in this truth. This is what really started the "Reformation." Luther was willing to die for this

good news of God's grace through Jesus Christ. Luther knew that what the Roman Catholic Church was doing was wrong, telling people that they had to do something, or buy indulgences to be saved.

What is one thing that is happening in the world today that you think is clearly wrong and against God's will? Would you protest against it? Would you take a risk in speaking out against it? How?

Luther is remembered for a few main things- translating the Bible, writing instructions for families. If you were remembered for ONE thing that you did or were in your life what would you like it to be?

Dear God, you call us to tell the world about the good news of grace and love for all through Jesus Christ. Help us to see who in our lives needs to hear this message.
