That prayerful attitude should consume us until the answer comes - and it will, if we are serious, open and patient.

The answer we get from God might very well gnaw on us for a long while, because of its demand on us. It may create internal tension, or tension with some other person: spouse or parent. However, one thing is certain: Pursuing your God given purpose will ultimately bring you unspeakable joy - guaranteed!

It should be understood, these questions with all of their intensity can and should be asked at any stage of life: student - career - retirement - old age. Our life's purpose will understandably change, evolving throughout the course of life. For that reason the question should be asked at all stages: What is my God-given purpose NOW?

At this juncture we need to know how to listen for God's answer to our questions. How do I discover what it is that God wants me to do now? What should I be about?

The answer will most certainly be hidden in your talents. What do you do best? What are you capable of? What brings you the most satisfaction? Are you an artist - a musician - a good conversationalist - a business

minded person? Your gifts should lead you to fulfilling God's purpose for your life. Keep seeking until you feel confident you have found it.

Another thing is certain: When your unique purpose is discovered and pursued, it will contribute to making the world a better place and\or the lives of people - or someone - enriched and more meaningful. It will have a significant ripple effect. It will have a creative edge and convey hope. God's modus operandi.

In turn, it will give you a profound sense of satisfaction and fulfillment. You will know deep inside yourself: *This is why I am here!*
