  - Safety and Security Team (Bill)
    - Currently mapping out signage for fire extinguishers
    - Discussed "usher awareness" instead of "usher training" more focused on helping hands before and after church
    - New Action Item: A member asked recently about making entryways handicap accessible – Bill checked into options; each door would be about \$4,500-\$5000 to make accessible
      - Michael suggested the Safety and Security Team check to see if the grant can cover some of these costs and, if not, that they develop a plan for how we might move forward with some options
    - Bill shared that we should hear back on the grant by late August or early September
  - OOW focused on the student housing initiative this past month and was able to donate \$2,678.30
    - This month's focus is suicide prevention in Larimer County

  - o Where would we like to go with volunteer information/hours collected?
    - A document was created to share out where our donations have been allocated during 2023

    - Kim documented volunteer hours collected on a separate document for May 2024

      - Shannon shared idea about creating a visual way to represent the organizations where OSLC members give of their time
      - Stuart encouraged us to also share the number of hours clocked since that's impactful information
      - Adrienne asked Council to email volunteer hours to Kimberly for May 2024 if they haven't done so already – deadline for May hours is Sunday, June 30<sup>th</sup>
