- Pleased with the attention that CAS (vendor) is still giving us in supporting our needs.
- The 'ReKey' is scheduled to happen on 8/20, and should help drive people to get a code for entry. Should happen seamlessly. People should reach out to Karyn/Mandy for help getting an assigned code.
- The Big Monitor will be installed for Staff to watch camera action better.
- The camera on the garage has a wiring challenge and will be corrected this week.
- We held Merit off on finishing up the last of the light changes due to Bill's travels and timing with FFH being in the building. Should wrap things up in the first 2 weeks of September.
- Roy is obtaining costs on additional door closures. Royal is working with the State to see if some of our various items are viewed as "security" items and could be added to our current grant.
- We will pinpoint \$\$\$ available and costs in September, as we get the direction needed to take action.
