- Committee reports (if available)
 - o Security Team (Bill)
 - New Equipment requested for door openers & ADA controls
 - Still researching the items needed, the costs and whether current items/hardware will work with new features.
 - State has OK'ed the add-on equipment to the Community Doors. Still have questions about the access and flow of a person with needs, on how convenient utilization works.
 - Sanctuary Doors cannot accept mechanical openers and will need to be replaced. Early quotes are between \$4k - \$11k.
 - Need to pass this issue on for help possibly; Bill asked whether Hillside Construction could be contacted for assistance – Pastor Leta shared that they're not interested, but we have other contacts we can reach out to for assistance with the door replacement if/when we move in that direction
 - Action on the Community Doors should be ready soon after a study on EHP again.
 - o Outside Our Walls (Dave)
 - September's shoe and funding drive for Homeward Alliance was a great success!
 Dozens of pairs of shoes were collected and \$3315 was distributed to HA.
 - October's activity is the annual Pine Ridge Clothing Drive. The list of needed items was expanded this year to include items such as food, toiletries, and diapers.
 - November activities:
 - Nov. 4th is the Pine Ridge clothing drive sorting event. This is a popular event that usually draws 20-30 volunteers to help sort and deliver clothes.
 - Another campaign for Homeward Alliance this time for handwarmers and for funding to help HA remodel their kitchen at the Murphy Center so they can serve hot meals. They are currently \$10k short of the \$50k needed to complete this project.
 - o Faith and Justice (Dave)
 - SNAP benefits will not be distributed in November due to the government shutdown.
 This is setting off alarm bells for many aid organizations throughout our nation. The Faith & Justice Team is helping out in 2 ways:
 - Bring awareness to the 100 families who participate in the Fort Collins CWS emergency food assistance program. This includes the Sayed family that our church has helped to support.

- Coordinate with the Larimer County Food Bank for assistance as demand will dramatically increase. The F&J team will be setting up volunteer times for our church to help out, similar to what we did back in July.
- The Interfaith Rally for Immigrant Rights was held on 10/16. Many organizations and individuals signed on to the "Declaration by People of Faith In Support of the Lives and Rights of Immigrants".
- Over 30 OSLC members attended the Oct. 5th No Kings rally, providing many positive messages and testimony to our faith.
- A "Sanctuary Stained Glass Window Rework or Artwork Task Force" has been created to provide recommendations for updating the stained glass in the sanctuary.
- o Habitat For Humanity (Dave)
 - o The FOCOLU Faith Builders team had a successful day of volunteering at their new work site at Heartside Hill (Lemay & Trilby). They helped with various tasks, including additions to the exterior (e.g., insulation, siding, and painting) and interior (e.g., trim, caulking, painting).
 - o The team is seeking donations of household items for the Habitat ReStore on Taft Hill Rd. They are also encouraging people to purchase ReStore gift cards to give away to people in need.
- Faith Family Hospitality (Dave)
 - o The OSLC FFH team is looking for a new volunteer coordinator to run our twice annual commitment to host families in need at our church. There will be an information session after both services this Sunday, Nov. 2nd, about the role.
